Chaminade Takes First in Regional Envirothon

Ten students competed in the Long Island Regional Envirothon on Tuesday, April 26, during Easter recess. Chaminade's Team 1 finished in first place for Nassau County for the fifth straight year, and in first place overall out of the 40 teams total from both Nassau and Suffolk. Team 1 had the highest scores in the following categories: Aquatics, Forestry, Soils (tie), and the Oral Presentation. Chaminade's Team 2 finished in 5th place for Nassau. Team 2 had a 3rd place finish in the category of Current Issue.

By finishing 1st place in the county Team 1 earned a trip to the New York State Envirothon later on this month. Sean Dvorak, Dan Ebanks, Rich Barakat, James Agolia, and Matt Walsh will compete against the 60 top Envirothon teams from across the state. The NYS Envirothon will take place on May 25-26, 2011, in Geneva, NY, at Hobart & William Smith Colleges.
