Oral Presentation Guidelines

All teams must participate in the oral presentation component of the LI Envirothon. The problem-solving/decision making component will be averaged into the final score of the competition. The oral presentation will be conducted as follows:



- Each team will have **ten minutes** to make their presentation before a panel of judges. The judges will have **five minutes** to ask the students questions after their presentation. Presentations must be **at least seven minutes** long **but no longer than ten minutes**.
- The presentations will take place during the testing rotation.
- All members of the team must participate in the presentation--everyone must have a speaking part.
- Students will be allowed to bring prepared visual aids to be used during the oral presentation before the judges. Visual aids can be made from the following materials:
 - 2 sheets of white poster board (22" x 28" each)
 - 1 small box Crayola markers (8 colors)
 - 1 package assorted construction paper (9" x 12"), 8 colors (2 sheets of each color) total of 16 sheets
 - 1 bottle Elmer's glue (Glue-all approximately 3 oz.)
 - 1 pair scissors
 - 2 pencils (standard #2)
- Students may be as creative as they want but must not use any materials that are not listed.
- Each member of the group is allowed to use one prepared note card (4" x 6" only) to aid them in their presentation. Anything larger will not be allowed. Note cards will **not** be allowed to be used as visual aids.
- Students should work with their fellow team members to prepare for the oral presentation station.
- Teams may organize their members to give the report in any way they choose.
